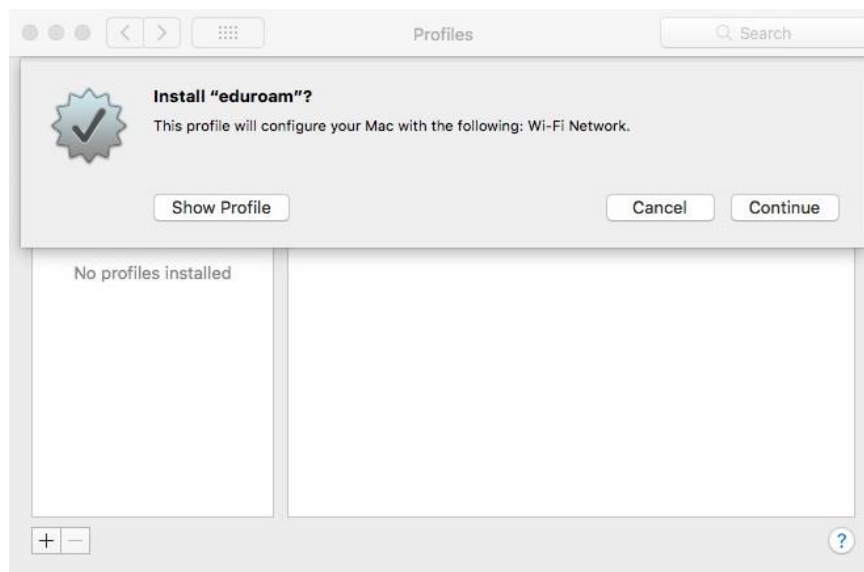


## eduroam for MacOS Clients

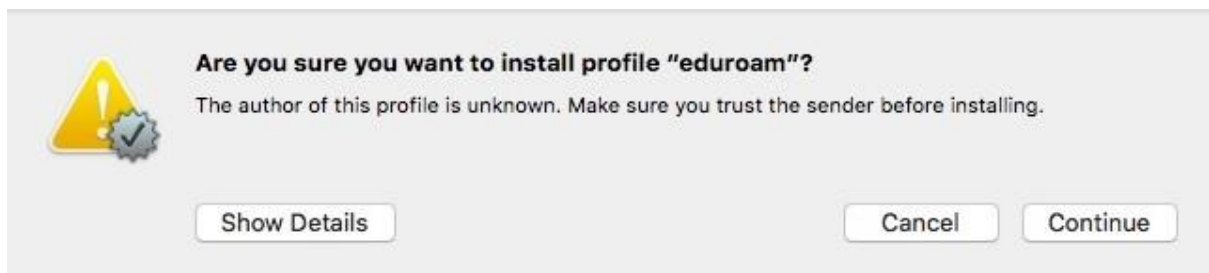

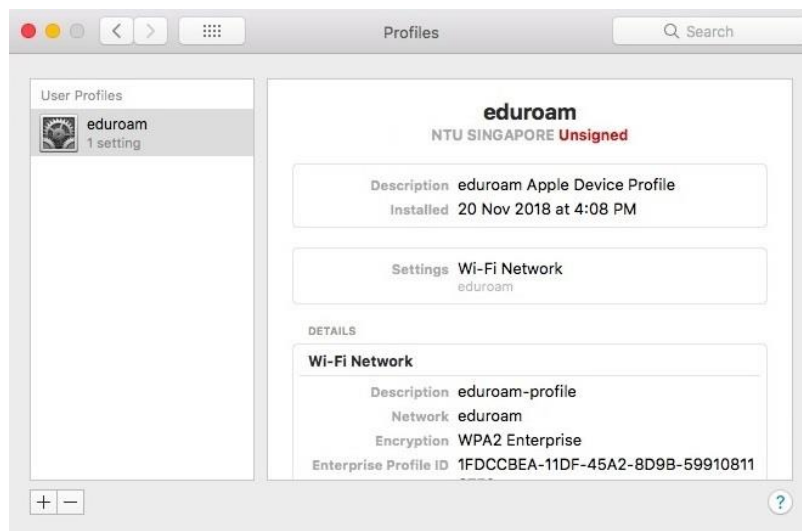

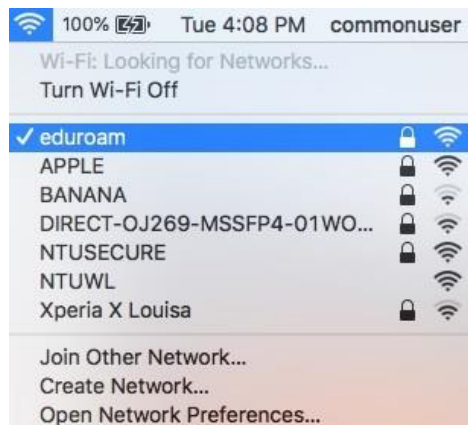

The below screen should be seen.



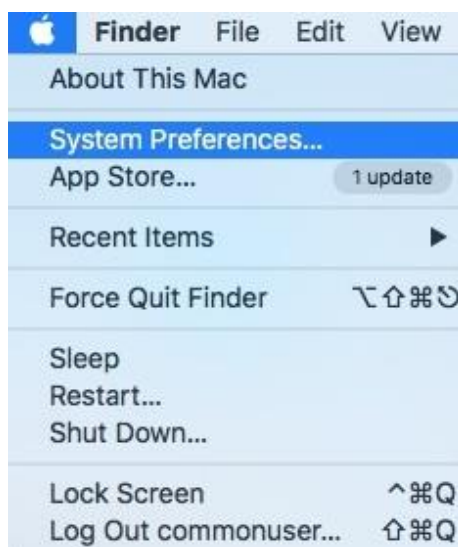
When near a wireless access area, connect to eduroam by clicking on the SSID "eduroam" from the MacBook wireless icon.

To remove the profile, navigate to "System Preferences..." from the top left-hand apple icon.



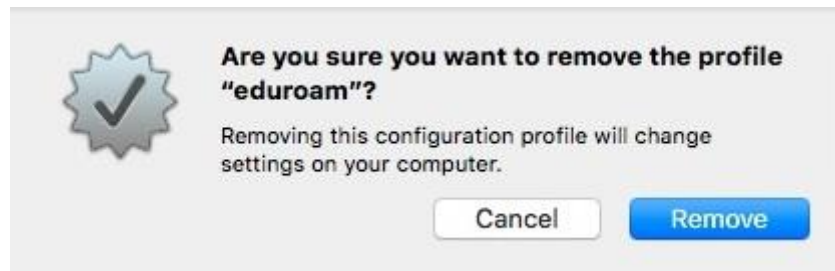
Click on "Profiles" at the bottom right of the screen.
