

## NTUSECURE for MacOS Clients

Older versions of MacOS running on TLS 1.0 are no longer supported due to security vulnerabilities. Please upgrade the MacOS to a higher version that supports TLS 1.2 and above. (**MacOS X 10.13 and above**)

Download the MacOS profile [here](#) and preload the MacBook with it.

Click on "Continue" to proceed with the profile installation.

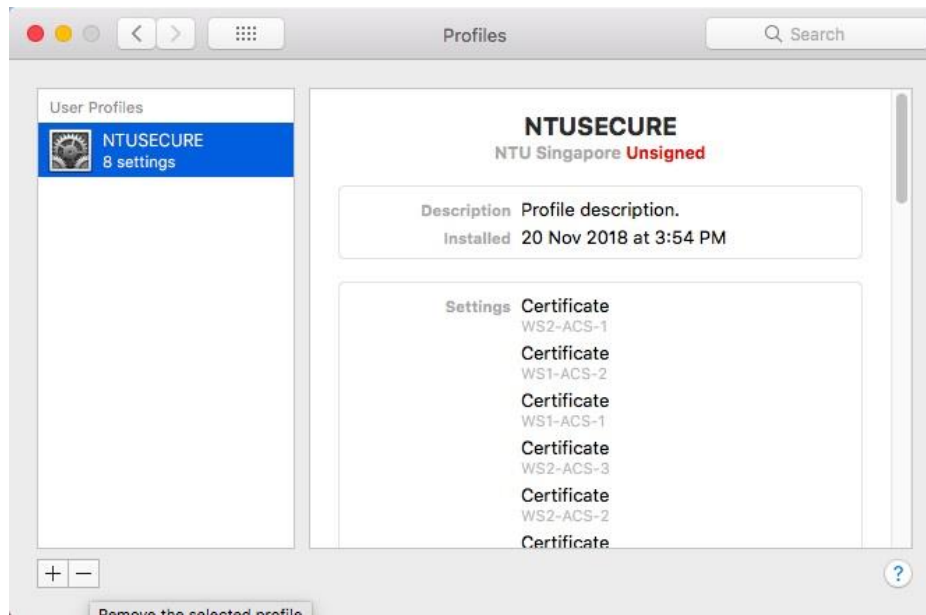
To remove the profile, navigate to "System Preferences..." from the top left hand apple icon



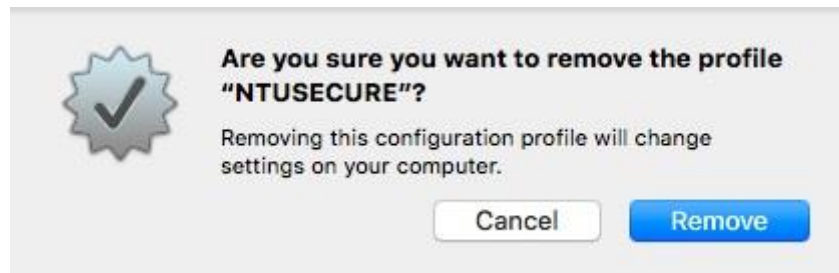
Click on "Profiles" at the bottom right of the screen
